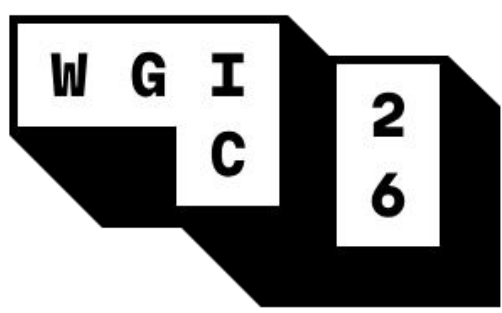




Early Bird tickets available until 30 September

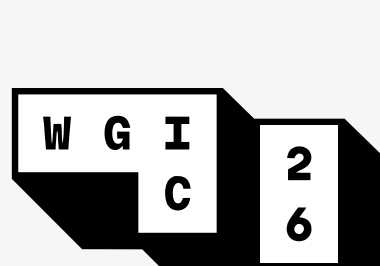
Explore Barcelona through WGIC26 Technical Visits
